

Salt Lake City Mayor's Bicycle Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes
5:00 pm, Canon Room, Salt Lake City/County Building
September 9, 2009.

Meeting commenced at 5:10 PM

1. Introductions of attendees

2. August Minutes were approved.

3. Matt Lyon- Mayor's Office:

- A. City Bike Maps: Funding is in process
- B. League of American Bicyclists Silver City designation- application is being reviewed for the next deadline.
- C. Stolen bike inventory to be donated to the Collective. The mechanism to make this happen is still on the City Council's agenda.
- D. Matt said the City is interested and supportive of having large events have monitored bike parking. Jamie Cowen will check on how other cities do it.

4. Pedicab Discussion:

As we know, Stick Dogs is in - Wasatch is out. Wasatch lost in their court battle. There were questions regarding how pedicabs operate to insure longevity of service- Matt Lyon will check on the ordinances that pedicabs operate under. How do other companies or individuals apply and provide service.

5. Transportation Report: Dan Bergenthal:

Dan reported that the video camera at Arapeen and Sunnyside is operating well. Uta from the University reported that the camera doesn't seem to work for her. Dan will check. The light-changing button at Sunnyside and guardsman however has been knocked down but operates. Green striped lanes on 2nd South should be touched up by the contractor in 2 weeks. 13th East bike lanes are now in place from 13th south to 6th South. PRATT trail through Parley's Historic Nature Park is under construction. New bike racks and event racks are on order. There is a need to improve efforts to get businesses to put in bike racks as required by ordinance. Interviews for new bike/ped person to work with Dan are in the 2nd phase. Dave noted that striped bike lanes are ending further from the intersection. There was discussion supportive of this practice and to the contrary. There was discussion of a need to cut back brush in City Creek Canyon to improve sight lines especially for right hand, blind turns. Intermodal Hub: looking for donor who will have naming rights.

6. Bicycle Film Festival is the 1st weekend in October

7. Police Liaison: Officer Lisa Pascadlo

Lisa is working on obtaining grants to help cyclists. There are budgeting issues. She needs data to obtain the grants but can't get the manpower to obtain the data due to budget constraints.

8. Transportation Advisory Board, Jon Springmeyer-

There has not been a Transportation Advisory Board meeting this month yet. Reported that Young Electric Sign Company (YESCO) will provide Share the Road public service advertisements.
